On Tuesday, July 1, 2014, Clayton County voted on a proposed November ballot measure that would ask its voters to raise the sales tax by a half-penny. This half-penny would cover bus service for the county, but not commuter rail. This proposal passed by a 3-to-2 vote.

The MARTA Board of Directors held a Special Board meeting today to take action on a half-penny proposal from Clayton County to join the MARTA system.

A Resolution Rejecting a Rapid Transit Contract Between the Authority and Clayton County which is Limited to Financial Participation by Clayton County at a Sales and Use Tax Rate of One Half of One Percent

On motion by Dr. Edmond seconded by Mr. Durrett, the resolution to reject a proposal for a half-penny sales tax passed by a unanimous vote of 8 to 0, with 9* members present.

Additionally, the MARTA Board voted on a resolution that called for a one-cent sales tax that would provide extension of transit services into Clayton County, including rail transit and surface bus transportation.

A Resolution Authorizing Approval of a Rapid Transit Contract Between the <u>Authority and Clayton County</u>

On motion by Mrs. Kaufman seconded by Mr. Daniels, the resolution passed by a unanimous vote of 8 to 0, with 9* members present.

In summary, the MARTA Board passed a resolution rejecting a proposal for a half-penny sales tax. The Board then passed a resolution approving a Rapid Transit Contract for Clayton County for the sales tax levy of one percent.
